Dear Friend:

The State of New Hampshire has authorized long-term care facilities to offer Outdoor Visits. However, there are stringent guidelines that Presidential Oaks must comply with for the safety of our residents and our staff members. **We will begin offering Outdoor Visits to Assisted Living Residents effective July 28, 2020.**

To schedule an Outdoor Visit, The Visitor must call 603-225-6644. Since Outdoor Visits are limited to (2) Visitors, both of whom must be over the age of 12 and arrive in (1) car, please coordinate with your family. Also, each visitor is required to answer questions about symptoms, exposure, and travel during the call. If this initial screen is successful, an Outdoor Visit will be scheduled. Outdoor Visits are being scheduled Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays and are limited to once every (3) weeks to ensure a fair rotation.

On the day of the Outdoor Visit, you will park in the designated Outdoor Visit parking space and call 603-225-6644. You must remain in your vehicle until the Nurse Assessor has completed the final screen. If the final screen is successful, you may exit your vehicle, don a face mask, sanitize your hands, and proceed to the designated Visitor Seating Area. During the Outdoor Visit, it is imperative that you do not approach the resident per the guidelines. Additionally, since you both must wear a face covering at all times, food or beverages are prohibited during the Outdoor Visit.

We are excited to be taking this step as we understand how much an in-person visit will mean!
