Out-Break Testing Beginning December 20th

Dear Residents and Family Members,

As we continue to navigate through the Covid-19 pandemic, Presidential Oaks believes communication is the utmost importance.

This message is just to make you aware that during daily screening today, it was determined that we have one positive Covid-19 resident on the 2nd Unit. We will now begin a period of Outbreak Testing with all residents to determine if there are more cases or if this is an isolated situation. This period of testing will take 24-72 hours and we also will be testing all our staff. This means the Christmas holiday may be impacted, and you need to be prepared that visits may be limited.

Third Floor Residents families have no restrictions on visits - but this could change on a daily basis.

As of today, Monday December 20th, we **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** that visitors for 2nd floor residents refrain from coming to the center during outbreak testing. (IF) you feel a compassionate visit is needed during this time, you will be screened at Reception Desk and provided a new mask, which HAS to be worn through-out your visit. Sanitizing your hands, wearing a mask and 6 feet social distancing must occur during all compassionate visits.

I know many family members are planning to take their residents home for a few hours- and over-night during the next few days. We **HIGHLY RECOMMEND** that this should not occur and we understand - this may impact your holiday plans - but the safety of our residents and your families must be considered at this time. We would also not be having Large Group Visits during this period.

We will keep everyone updated over the next few days on the status of this current situation. Please check your emails daily and you can always call reception, to receive any updates.
