Dear Residents and Family Members,

We are pleased to inform you that visitation has returned to its regular schedule following the latest round of testing for staff and residents. So at this time, there is no need to schedule visits to see residents on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

Guests will no longer be required to wear an N95 mask during visits, however, with the Covid-19 transmission rate hovering around 25% in Merrimack County, we do encourage you to wear one. Presidential Oaks will no longer be supplying N95 masks.

Although scheduling visits is no longer required, please remember all previous restrictions to remain in place. These include:

- No more than two (2) visitors per resident at a time
- All visitors must be screened for temperature and Covid-19 related questions upon entry
- No children age 16 or under will be allowed to visit at this time
- No eating or drinking during visits
- Masks must be worn at all times and must cover both your nose and mouth
- Sanitize your hands
- Maintain a 6-foot social distance during your visit

As a reminder, staff members are permitted to discontinue a visit if a guest does not comply with these requirements. There are **NO** exceptions! We appreciate your flexibility with the ever-changing landscape of the Covid-19 pandemic and will continue to update you with any changes. If you have any questions, please call us at 603-225-6644.
