Dear Residents and Family Members,

GOOD NEWS! We are happy to report that last week, during our most recent round of surveillance testing for residents and staff, we had NO NEW POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES on the 2nd floor!

Assuming that there will be no new positive cases in this week's round of testing, Presidential Oaks will soon be able to loosen a few restrictions within the building.

Once the test results are back and confirm that no Covid-19 cases are active within the Presidential Oaks community, restrictions will be reviewed and modified. And we will be able to start "mixing and mingling" between the 2nd and 3rd floor once again for activities and socializing.

However, for now, the previous restrictions do remain in place. These include:

- No more than two (2) visitors per resident at a time
- All visitors must be screened for temperature and Covid-19 related questions upon entry
- No eating or drinking during visits
- Masks **MUST** be worn at all times and must cover both your nose and mouth
- Sanitize your hands and please maintain a 6-foot social distance during your visit

As a reminder, staff members are permitted to discontinue a visit if a guest does not comply with these requirements. There are **NO** exceptions!

Visitation is from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Updated information is emailed out and you can also call reception at 225-6644 to receive any updates. Information is also posted on the Presidential Oaks website and Facebook page. Thank you!!
