Dear Residents and Family Members,

We have completed the final round of surveillance testing for residents and staff following our most recent Covid-19 cases last month and we are SO GRATEFUL to report that due to no new positive test results, Presidential Oaks has announced an update to Covid-19 protocols in the facility.

Visitors will still be screened upon entering the community and masks MUST be worn and MUST cover both your nose and mouth. We also continue to request that you sanitize your hands upon arrival.

However, due to the low positivity rate in Merrimack County and the decline in cases within Presidential Oaks, we are able to make a few updates to the visitation protocols:

- There is no longer a restriction of two (2) visitors per resident at a time
- Visitors may eat or drink during visits, but are asked to keep their masks on otherwise
- Children are once again welcome to visit and will be screened upon entry

We also ask that you remain flexible as the Covid-19 situation can change at any time. As a reminder, staff members are permitted to discontinue a visit if a guest does not comply with these requirements. There are **NO** exceptions!

Visitation is from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily. Updated information is emailed out and you can also call reception at 603-225-6644 to receive any updates. Information is also posted on the Presidential Oaks website and Facebook page. Thank you for your continued patience and support of Presidential Oaks!!
