Dixieland and jazz will be the musical menu for Tuesday, June 30 as the Fountain Square Ramblers will perform, followed by the smooth and easy sounds of East Bay Jazz on July 14.

Bedford Big Band will showcase all the classics of the grand Big Band Era on July 28. Big Band, swing and beyond will also be featured on Aug. 11 when the Freese Brothers perform. Rounding out the series on Aug. 25 will be another local favorite, the Concord Coachmen with their harmonic barbershop and doo-wop melodies.

The concerts begin at 6:30 p.m. and will be held rain or shine. In the event of inclement weather, the concerts will move inside to the newly-renovated, accessible Presidential Oaks Auditorium.

There is no cost to attend the concerts and guests are welcome to bring a blank or their own lawn chairs, however chairs will be provided. Complimentary popcorn and bottled water will be handed out to guests.

Three of the concert dates will also feature a theme dinner prior to the show, which is also complimentary of Presidential Oaks.

On June 16, July 14 and Aug. 11 guests may reserve a seat for a dinner. Menu for the July 16 meal include grilled salmon with teriyaki sauce, peas, ginger rice and strawberry shortcake.
